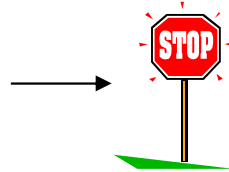


Does your research involve health information about living participants or about deceased persons, regardless of how it will be collected (from intervention, interaction, chart review, and/or stored in databases or repositories)?



YES

Will you be accessing, collecting, recording, or using health information linked to personal identifiers (at any time)?

YES

Complete the notification of decedent research form and submit to the IRB Office. An IRB Application is not required.

NO

Does your study involve obtaining/recording health information with identifiers?

Research data is considered de-identified per HIPAA. Submit accordingly on IRB Application.

YES

Is your research a chart review in which only limited identifiers are recorded (age, individual dates (DOB, dates of service), and city, state, zip codes)?

Research data is considered a limited dataset. An internal or external DUA should be included in IRB Application/materials.

NO

Will the study involve the obtaining/recording of health information that can be linked to an individual directly or through a code that can be linked to a master list?

Research data is considered identifiable per data/specimens from deceased persons?
